Survey Results:

- Year-End Survey Preliminary Findings
- 77 respondents (roughly ½ membership)
- 77% feel their player had a positive experience
- 64% feel their players skill progressed
- 72% feel coaches had a positive impact

Areas to enhance:

- more practice ice (early in the season)
- goalie development (some but more would be nice)
- · improved discipline, reduced penalty at the Bantam and Midget levels
- extended discussion around ice time and available practice ice
- share with coaches ice time that is available at the start of the season

Affliates:

- inform and educate coaches around policy next season
- players don't need to be affiliated to attend practices
- 19 player rule

Ice Scheduling:

- Distribution again heavy on weekends
- 28.5 hours per week to distribute
- Ice Allocation Policy 3hrs (games and/or practices)

- Changes for next season
 - No ice on Grey Cup or Super Bowl
 - No Beckwith or GRC ice in March
 - Reduce ice due to Novice cross-ice

Tournament:

- November 8-11, 2019
- 5 Divisions: Novice, Minor Atom, Atom, Peewee, Bantam
- 28 teams
- Profit \$3,514
- HEO made an error with the sanctions
- Due to our location it's difficult to fill

Risk and Safety:

- Respect initiative
- Coach first philosophy, when they need help they approach the board
- D4 website has a link to submit ref concerns, to be added to ORHC site
- If out of district concerns, inform our President and they will address
- Second year of Respect Initiative with a focus on treatment of officials
- The club added time to suspensions where it felt it was warranted
- 2019-2020 Priorities
 - Continue with Respect Initiative
 - Continue to work with coaches at the team level regarding player discipline/behavior
- 2019-20
 - Ottawa Police fees for PRC?

Budget:

- Operating surplus of \$29,762
- Registration was down less Novice players
- Tournament revenue lower than projected
- Ref fees higher
- More was spent on coach certification
- Only 3 teams used their goalie allocations

- Next year, rev will be down with no Novice team
- Expenses will be the same
- Ice costs going up 5% so our fees will increase slightly
- We will have paid time keepers next year Atom Bantam 1, Midget 2
- Will come out of the ref budget
- We need a committee of 3 non signing members to review financials vs bank balance every 2 months.

Looking Ahead:

- Coach Mentorship
 - Practice & game evaluations with timely feedback / reporting
 - Substantial focus on Novice, Atom, and Peewee levels
 - Additional focus on goalie development
 - Look at approaching a facility for a training package
- Tournaments
 - Paid timekeepers/scorekeepers
 - Possible expansion
