Survey Results

- Year-End Survey Preliminary Findings
- 23 respondents
- 65% feel their player had a positive experience
- 65% feel their players skill progressed
- 87% feel coaches had a positive impact

Areas to enhance:

- more practice ice (early in the season and before playoffs)
- guest coaches / non-parent development sessions

- B League maximum 4 players+goalies
- District 2 players+1 goalie/team (new 2020-21)
- District stay within District as best as possible
- Romans restrict imports at Atom/Peewee levels to develop local talent

Ice Scheduling



Ice Scheduling

- Distribution again heavy on weekends
- 28.5 hours per week to distribute
- Ice Allocation Policy 3hrs (games and/or practices)
- Changes for next season
 - Atom pathways limit number of games
 - Atom pathways minimum practices before first league game
 - No ice on Grey Cup or Super Bowl
 - No Beckwith or GRC ice in March

Risk and Safety

- District 4 added additional games on abuse of official misconducts.
- The club added time to suspensions where it felt it was warranted
- 2020-2021 Priorities
 - Continue with Respect Initiative
 - Enforce dressing room 2-deep policy to limit bullying incidents
 - Video taping all games. No appeals if no video evidence.



Risk and Safety

- 2020-21
 - Ottawa Police fees for PRC is \$20 with a letter
 - Volunteer letters available starting May 15th.

 - Use Ottawa Police Services online Vulnerable Sector Police Records Check service.
 - All volunteers will be reimbursed (keep your receipt)
 - PRC good for three years

2019-20 Operating Budget

Statement of Operations:

Actual Planned

Total Revenue: \$185,066 \$209,253

Total Expenses: \$182,396 \$207,573

Operating Surplus: \$2,670 \$1,680



2019-2020 Commentary

- Revenue down approximately \$23,500 from budget related to Midget team not participating
 - Reduction in registration fees of ~17 players
 - One less club fee (\$9,750)
- Ice costs down approximately \$24,000 from budget related to return of ice from Midget games and practices as well as cancellation of ice from mid-March onwards
- Cost of referees/timekeepers down \$3,800 again due to Midget



2020/2021 OPERATING BUDGET

- What changes do we expect?
 - Increase in ice costs (~\$5/hr to \$200.45/hr)
 - Increase in Referee costs
 - Increase in player/coach insurance
 - Uncertainty around season start and format
 - Player fee alignment by association and age group to be adopted

Looking ahead



REGISTRATION

- Registration delayed until further notice
 - Waiting on additional information from Hockey Canada and Hockey Eastern Ontario (HEO)
- When Registration opens
 - Likely a minimal fee to "hold your spot"
 - Payment plan option
 - Registration deadline deferred
 - Check your home association for more details



2019-20 Looking Ahead

- Online Forms
 - Rowans Law
 - Tryout registration and 4 on 4/ Clinics
 - Online payment for tryouts and fees
- Tryouts
 - Reversible jerseys, number assigned to player, use same jersey until lost or no longer fits
 - Use reversible jerseys for exhibition games during tryouts



2019-20 Looking Ahead

- Atom Pathways
 - Later start to game-play
 - Reduced number of games
 - 20 game regular season
 - 40 game maximum
 - 1 to 1 ratio for practices and games
 - exact format and timing TBD
 - Look to host information night closer to season start
