2020-21 Year in Review



COVID Hockey highlights

- Season started September 19
- Season paused briefly October 14
- Additional ice purchased for 28 days in Red zone
- Return to "normal" numbers November 9
- Season paused December 21 until February 18
- Season ended March 18
- Teams bubbled with Stittsville Rams, Metcalfe Jets, GOB Blues
- Total 370 hours of ice across 8 teams

- District stay within District as best as possible
- Romans restrict imports at Atom/Peewee levels to develop local talent

Ice Scheduling

- Ice Allocation Policy 3hrs per week (games and/or practices)
- Changes for next season
 - Atom pathways limit number of games
 - Atom pathways minimum number of practices before first league game
 - No ice on Grey Cup or Super Bowl
 - No Beckwith or GRC ice in March

Risk and Safety

- Each team added a Safety Officer to its staff. The role of the Safety Officer was to ensure the accurate tracking of player and parent attendance at each practice and game. Our Romans Safety Officers did a fantastic job!
- HEO will be implementing the Green Arm Band Initiative for younger Officials.
- 2021-2022 Priorities
 - Ensure Coaching Qualifications and PRC's are up to date
 - Video taping all games. No appeals if no video evidence.

Total Revenue: \$118,505 \$122,575

Total Expenses: \$102,435 \$120,902

Operating Surplus: \$16,070 \$1,673



2020-2021 Commentary

- Ice costs down approximately \$20,500 from budget related to return of ice in March and discounted ice costs
- All administrative costs down
 - Insurance
 - Referees
 - Certifications
- Refunds will be issued and applied to next year's registration fees unless refund requested (~\$125)



2021-22 OPERATING BUDGET

- What changes do we expect?
 - Dependent on direction from Public Health
 - Increase in ice costs (~\$10/hr to \$210/hr)

 - Tryout registration
 - 4 on 4 / Checking clinics

Tryouts

- Reversible jerseys, number assigned to player, use same jersey until lost or no longer fits
- Use reversible jerseys for exhibition games during tryouts



2021-22 Looking Ahead

- Atom Pathways
 - Later start to game-play
 - Reduced number of games
 - 20 game regular season
 - 40 game maximum
 - 1 to 1 ratio for practices and games
 - exact format and timing TBD
 - Look to host information night closer to season start
