Survey Results

- Year-End Survey Preliminary Findings
- 77 respondents (roughly ½ membership)
- 77% feel their player had a positive experience
- 64% feel their players skill progressed
- 72% feel coaches had a positive impact

Areas to enhance:

- better communication from board, coaches, managers
- more practice ice (early in the season)
- improved discipline, reduced penalty at the Bantam and Midget levels
