

## **Survey Results**

- Year-End Survey Preliminary Findings
- 58 respondents (43% of members)
- 83 % feel their player had a positive experience
- 69 % feel their players skill progressed
- 73 % feel coaches had a positive impact

## Ice Scheduling

- Distribution again heavy on weekends. A few arenas were shut down this season
- No Manotick ice at time of ice submission for games
- 28.5 hours per week to distribute
- Ice Allocation Policy 3hrs (games and/or practices)
- Changes for next season
  - Reduce/eliminate ice time at Winchester
  - Return to Manotick
  - Fixed block of ice from ORMHA and RMMHA

- Player Development
